<u>PANTRY REPORT:</u> Steve Cline took the past-use-date food to the food bank, and he updated us on the increased prices of specific groceries he purchases for our pantry. Steve talked to the Asst. Executive Director of Concern for Neighbors Food Bank and he will be meeting with him. The food bank offered to provide food for our pantry.

<u>REQUESTS / ASSIGNMENTS:</u> Barb Whalen reported that all the requests were current.

COUNCIL REPORT: Bridget Rosen reported:

- Inga reached out to a former donor who called back and gave \$50,000 for the bed program.
- There will be two Top Hat awards (one event). One for Vincentians, and one for someone, or an organization outside of SVDP.
- The overnight parking for women with children living in cars at the SVDP Monroe Resource Center got the go ahead and will open soon. There will be funding (not sure from whom) for help to get these women into an apartment.
- Save Environment process is taking longer to setup than expected. Holy Rosary will be enrolled in Virtus first and after the bugs are worked out, the rest of the conferences in our council will be enrolled.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Thanksgiving/Christmas Planning:
 - Distribution will be from the Multi-Purpose Room of Mercy House. Basket preparation was discussed for the 30 baskets. Steve said that he would begin purchasing groceries as they become available at the best prices.
- Commuter checks (certificates for ORCA): Barb & Colleen Whalen picked them up and they are in the pantry. Bridget reminded everyone to notify her, or Carole, when we are down to a couple of sheets or 10 gift cards. The Blue Book with gift cards and ORCA script is on the shelf on the west wall.
- Pulpit Talk: Nov. 4th and 5th. Maureen will be presenting. Tables will be setup at the doors with SVDP information. Volunteers are needed to staff the tables after each mass.
- Mercy House: The Mercy House Potluck has been canceled.
